

## Disciplinary Actions:

Reprimand - is a formal notice which expresses concern for recognized wrongdoing but does not restrict the nurse's right to practice.

Stay of Suspension - is a formal notice of the consequences that will be imposed should the nurse fail to comply with defined requirements such as required remedial education and/or practice conditions.

Probation - involves imposing conditions for practice and monitoring of the nurse's practice for a specified period of time.

Suspension - is the loss of the privilege to practice nursing for a specified period of time

Surrender - a formal action which allows the nurse to relinquish her/his right to practice nursing for a period of time not less than 1 year.

Revocation - the loss of the right to practice nursing for a period of not less than 5 years.
