

Checklist for Clinical Placement Requests – Out of State Students

In accordance with <u>21 NCAC 36 .0233</u>, unlicensed nursing students enrolled in out of state education programs may participate in clinical experiences at North Carolina healthcare facilities only after receiving approval from the North Carolina Board of Nursing (NCBON). To ensure out of state student requests are complete and meet all submission requirements, follow this step-by-step checklist.
