- NCBON provides this module/skills checklist as a courtesy for use in training any unlicensed personnel.
- Only the licensed nurse (RN or LPN) may assess test results and implement ordered interventions.
- Blood glucose lancets should never be shared among clients.
- Blood glucose monitors may be shared only when thoroughly cleaned between clients per agency policies and procedures.
- Finger stick capillary blood glucose testing is considered a non-nursing function (see Position Statement "Delegation: Non-Nursing Functions at www.ncbon.com Position Statements).
- Competency validation should occur in the clinical area whenever possible; however, in those limited situations where this is not possible, laboratory simulation of the clinical setting is permissible.
- Only the RN may provide nurse aide training and competency validation. The LPN may provide subsequent delegation and supervision when working with a nurse aide.

- 1. Obtains directions from licensed nurse
- 2. Identify the patient
- 3. Explain the procedure to the patient
- 4. Assemble the equipment and supplies based on agency protocol: Example:
  - (a) cotton ball
  - (b) alcohol swab
  - (c) test strip
  - (d) finger lancing device
  - (e) latex glove (universal precautions use throughout the procedure)
  - (f) blood glucose monitoring machine
- 5. Test glucose monitoring machine for accuracy (calibration) if necessary
- 6. Uses correct testing strip for machine
- 7. Puts on gloves
- 8. Assemble finger lancing device
- 9. Prepare site for finger stick
- 10. Pricks side of a fingertip using a lancet or automatic finger puncture device
- 11. Places adequate amount of blood on test area of strip
- 12. Times procedure accurately (if necessary)
- 13. Disposes of lancet properly
- 14. Read the results at correct time
- 15. Record results according to agency policy
- 16. Reports results to licensed nurse
