Executive Summary

This report examines characteristics of the nursing student population and the programs in which those students are enrolled in North Carolina. The charts and data tables are based on information provided by all entry-level nursing education programs to the North Carolina Board of Nursing each year during the month of October. The nursing education pipeline data will contribute to the analysis of how well current policy initiatives are being met, as well as determination of what new policies might be needed to ensure adequate future nursing resources.

Findings from this year's analysis show a reported increase in the total number of qualified applicants to practical nursing, entry level RN, and RN-BSN programs between 2008-2009 and 2009-2010 academic years. The number of new enrollees in all programs remained relatively stable in all program types. The RN-BSN enrollment continued to increase in this data collection cycle.

There has been a steady pattern of growth in the overall number of graduates from entry-level RN programs in the state from 2004-2010. During the current reporting cycle, there was a decrease in generic Associate Degree RN Graduates and LPN Advanced Placement Associate Degree RN graduates. There was an increase in the number of practical nurse graduates, and graduates from Hospital diploma, pre-licensure BSN, accelerated BSN, and generic MSN programs. The number of RN-BSN graduates also increased in the 2009-2010 reporting timeframe. The age profile of nursing students has remained relatively unchanged over the reporting period. The overall percentage of students from racial and ethnic minority groups has increased to 23.2% for 2010, an increase from the 2009 18.9%, but still lower than the 24.8% reported in 2007. It is notable; however, that the number of students from racial and ethnic minority groups decreased in diploma, generic associate degree RN, and pre-licensure BSN programs during 2010. The percentage of male students increased from 10% reported in 2009 to 11% for the 2010 report period.

An increase in budgeted full time faculty positions and a decrease in budgeted part time faculty positions were reported in the 2010 data. An overall increase in vacancy rate for full time faculty from 3.2% to 4.1% was reported for 2010. An overall increase in vacancy rate for part time faculty was reported from 2.5% in 2009 to 4.1% in 2010.

Consistent with our strategic initiative to enhance the Board's proactive leadership in public protection by supporting innovations in education and practice that promote a competent nursing workforce, we continue to gather annual supply data on the nursing student population and trends and make this information available to educators, employers, and other interested parties. 

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
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
Applications, Admissions, and New Enrollees by Nursing Program and Student Types, Academic Year 2009-2010









Total Enrollments on October 1, 2010 by Student Type



Age Profile of Nursing Students Enrolled in North Carolina as of October 1, 2010





NOTE:

The annual counts of “starts” and “grads” are an aggregation of all prelicensure students scheduled to graduate within that academic year given the curriculum sequence of the program in which they are enrolled. If a program offered more than the traditional full-time class schedule (i.e. a program “option”) student cohorts from those program options are also included in the program’s annual counts.

“Total cohort starts” is thus the sum of students in all entering cohorts who – according to the curriculum sequence of their program or program option – were scheduled to graduated in a given year. “Total cohort grads” is the sum of students from those entering cohorts that graduated on-time. The 3 year aggregated on-time completion rate for each program is calculated as follows:

Total starts over 3 years = (2008 total cohort starts + 2009 total cohort starts + 2010 total cohort starts)

Total grads over 3 years = 2008 total cohort grads + 2009 total cohort grads + 2010 total cohort grads)

3 year completion rate = (Total grads over 3 years / total starts over 3 years) *100

A 3 year on-time completion rate is also computed for each program type (PNE, Diploma, ADN and BSN). That rate is calculated by dividing the total number of graduates over the past 3 years aggregated from all programs in that category by the total number of “cohort starts” over the past 3 years aggregated from all programs in that category. This is the same calculation method that is used for each program individually. The NC Board of Nursing used the aggregated 3-year completion rate reported in this table for each nursing education program, along with their NCLEX pass rates, to determine eligibility for expansion.
