Executive Summary

This report examines characteristics of the nursing student population and the programs in which those students are enrolled in North Carolina. The charts and data tables are based on information provided by all entry-level nursing education programs to the North Carolina Board of Nursing each year during the month of October. The nursing education pipeline data will contribute to the analysis of how well current policy initiatives are being met, as well as determination of what new policies might be needed to ensure adequate future nursing resources.

Findings from this year's analysis show a reported decrease in the total number of qualified applicants to practical nursing and entry level RN, and an increase in RN-BSN programs in 2009-2010 and 2010-2011 academic years. The number of new enrollees in the practical nursing and entry level RN programs increased, while the RN-BSN programs decreased.


The numbers have remained stable in the overall number of graduates from entry-level RN programs in the state from 2006-2011. During the current reporting cycle, hospital diploma, pre-licensure BSN, pre-licensure MSN and practical nurse graduates remained essentially the same. There was a slight decrease in generic associate degree RN and LPN advanced placement graduates. There was an increase in the number of pre-licensure BSN and accelerated BSN graduates. The number of RN-BSN graduates also increased in the 2010-2011 reporting timeframe.

The age profile of nursing students has remained relatively unchanged over the reporting period. The overall percentage of students from racial and ethnic minority groups has increased slightly to 23.7% for 2011, an increase from the 2010 23.2%, but still lower than the 24.8% reported in 2007. It is notable; however, that the number of students from racial and ethnic minority groups decreased in generic RN and generic associate degree RN programs during 2011. The percentage of male students remains the same at 11% for the 2011 report period.

An increase in budgeted full time faculty positions and part time faculty positions were reported in the 2011 data. A slight increase in vacancy rate for full time faculty from 4.1% to 4.4% was reported for 2011. An overall decrease in vacancy rate for part time faculty was reported from 4.1% in 2010 to 2.6% in 2011.



Applications, Admissions, and New Enrollees by Nursing Program and Student Types, Academic Year 2010-2011






Trends in New Student Enrollments by Nursing Program and Student Types



New Enrollees by Nursing Program Type and Student Types




Trends in Total Enrollment in North Carolina Nursing Education Programs


Trends in Total Graduates from North Carolina Nursing Education Programs

Age Profile of Nursing Students Enrolled in North Carolina as of October 1, 2011




